



Ask Ed Follow Up Process Idea

Need:

- Copy of the student's Ask Ed Special Report
- Laminated 'Thanks for Asking Ed' cards
- Large Ed for display

Questions to the student

1. What was your problem?
2. Did you use any of your ideas?
3. Which ideas have you tried?
4. What happened?
5. How are you feeling about the problem now?
6. What Catastrophe Scale rating would you give the problem now?
7. Do you want to use Ask Ed again?
8. Do you have any other questions?

Use Ask Ed if the student has indicated they want to work through the problem again or if they have a new problem. Print the report. Ask them what they will do with the report and where they will keep it. (Demonstrates that the report and the student's thinking are valued.)

Finally shake their hand and present them with a small, laminated 'Thanks for Asking Ed'.

IDEA: Use a hole punch to punch a hole in the top corner of the Thank You card. Tie on a piece of wool or string. Students could tie the Thank You card to their school bag or pencil case.

Large Ask Ed

Laminate and cut out. Ed can be propped up on the table when you are using the Ask Ed app with a student or during 'follow up time.'



Ask Ed Thank You Tags *Laminate then cut along the lines. Present the 'Thanks for Asking Ed' after the follow up session. Idea: Use a hole punch to make a hole in the top left hand corner. Add string or ribbon. Students could attach to their school bag or pencil case.*



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
